You'll also have some free time to take in some of the shops in town as well as the Submarine Museum there too. We'll enjoy an included lunch here too!
- A lunch at Skipper's in Darien, Georgia is also planned for the way home too. Love their beautiful river front location.
- Everyone will be on their own for dinners each night, and downtown offers you a host of great choices!
- Shopping time in pretty downtown too.
